- → The ski pass is non-transferable.
- → The ski pass must be presented or handed over to cable car personnel
- → Lost ski passes will be replaced on presentation of proof of sale and for a handling fee.
- → Forgotten passes will not be replaced.
- → Claims made after the fact will not be accepted!
- → ID requirement: The age of children, youths, and seniors or other reasons for obtaining a discounted ski pass must be proven upon request with an appropriate photo ID when purchasing tickets as well as upon admission.
 - Please understand that without identification neither free tickets nor discounts can be granted.
- → Controls after the turnstile/at the lift entrance: Guests in this area are in the control zone.
